MCI/MCO Drill will be structure fire with casualties. One of the scenarios being considered is a fire in a long term care or senior home. The drills will take place September 6th, 7th, 8th 0900-1200 & 1300 – 1600/ September 13th, 14th, and 15th 0900-1200. The drill will involve 10 to 12 patients.
